Trip to Branson, Missouri

You might choose to add a day or two to your trip to take in attractions such as Silver Dollar City, a one-of-a-kind 1880s theme park, or Sight & Sound Theatre, known for its epic Bible-themed stage productions. Branson is a two-and-a-half-hour drive from Siloam Springs, and a popular go-to vacation spot for people of all ages in our area, with lots of shopping and dining options.

- 1. Drive 2.5 hours to <u>Silver Dollar City</u> [Adults \$62, Children 4–11 \$51, open 9:30am–7pm].
- 2. Another option is <u>Sight & Sound Theatre</u>, currently showing "Moses" [Adults 13+ \$45, Children 3–12 \$19, open Tuesday-Saturday].
- 3. Head to the **Branson Landing** for shopping and dinner. Walk the scenic boardwalk along the Taneycomo lakefront. Stop to watch the water and fire show [occurs on the hour] in the square. If you are an outdoor enthusiast, stop to shop at **Bass Pro Shop** [open till 9pm]. There are many places to stop for dinner at the Landing: Try *Waxy Shea's* for an Irish Pub, *Pie Five* for Pizza, *Cantina Laredo* for authentic Mexican, or choose from many more. If you're just looking for dessert, try *Dino's Cake & Coffee, The Fudgery*, or *Marble Slab Creamery*.
- 4. Another local favorite is <u>Danna's BBQ & Burger Shop</u>. The burgers are great and the Banana Foster dessert is amazing and big enough to share.
